

Decisions from “EUROCHIP-3 action proposal in Romania” (A. Baban)

- Report for Ministry of Health with data for a working Organized CCS in Romania, learning from the experiences in EUROPE, covering:
 - (a) Cost effectiveness data of an organised cancer screening programme in Romania and comparison with European Standards: Pilot Study is recommended (application to National Financing Research programme in preparation)
 - (b) Surveys: data from cytology labs auto-evaluation, programme evaluations by the public;
 - (c) Plan of needed resources (facilities, training medical staff, insiders and general public information campaigns).Collaboration with National Institute of Public Health and Center for Medical Statistics
- Organization of a session on Cervical Cancer Screening in the ALASS WORKSHOP in Romania, presenting the EUROCHIP-3 experiences to local stakeholders. First Drafts by end February 2009.

Decisions from “EUROCHIP-3 actions proposal in Bulgaria” (Y. Panayotova)

- Local researchers need aid in presenting to the authority the already existing CCS Programme Proposal, need of Cost Effectiveness data, circulation Guidelines.
- Pilot study should be started.
- Proposal focuses on: Public Awareness, Training Campaigns and preparation of the Invitation Pack
